List of the Codes of the Types of Goods for Children in Accordance with the Commodity Classification of Foreign Economic Activity of the Russian Federation Imposable with Value-Added Tax at the 10 per Cent Tax in Their Importation into the Customs Territory of the Russian Federation.

2. To establish that this Decision shall enter into force upon the expiry of one month from the day of its official publication but not earlier than the first day of the next tax period.
