## RESOLUTION

## No.625 of May 12, 2004

### Kiev

ON MEASURES REGARDING PLEDGE OPERATIONS WITH GRAIN HARVESTED IN 2004

As amended and changed by the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No.876 of July 7, 2004

With the purpose of stabilizing the grain market the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine hereby **decrees**:

- 1. To establish the level of pledge prices for grain of basic conditions (value-added tax left out) for the term of July 1, 2004 to March 1, 2005 as appears in the Appendix.
- 2. The State Joint-Stock Company "Khlib Ukrainy" shall take measures to carry out pledge operations with grain harvested in 2004 in the size at least 0.5 mln. t at the expense of the state budget.
- 3. The Ministry of Finance, the Ministry of Economy and European Integration, the Ministry of Agrarian Policy and the State Joint-Stock Company "Khlib Ukrainy" shall develop proposals as to making amendments to the Law of Ukraine "On the State Budget of Ukraine in 2004" as refers to the allocation of funds for performing grain operations.
