

LAW OF UKRAINE

“On Amendments to Certain Legislative Acts of Ukraine in respect of Legal Protection of Intellectual Property (in respect of Compliance with Commitments relating to the Accession of Ukraine to the WTO)”

The Supreme Rada of Ukraine hereby R E S O L V E S:

I. To amend the following legislative acts of Ukraine:

1. In the Criminal Code of Ukraine (Vidomosti Verkhovnoji Rady [*Bulletin of the Supreme Rada of Ukraine*] (VVR), 2001, No. 25 – 26, page 131, 2003, No. 35, page 271, 2006, No. 26, page 211):

1) To add the words “and destruction” after the words “subject to seizure” in paragraph 2 of Part 1, paragraph 2 of Part 2 and paragraph 2 of Part 3 in Article 176;

2) To add the words “and destruction” after the words “subject to seizure” in paragraph 2 of Part 1, paragraph 2 of Part 2 and paragraph 2 of Part 3 in Article 177;

3) To add the words “and destruction” after the words “subject to seizure” in paragraph 2 of Part 1, paragraph 2 of Part 2 and paragraph 2 of Part 3 in Article 229;

2. In Article 432 of the Civil Code of Ukraine (Vidomosti Verkhovnoji Rady [*Bulletin of the Supreme Rada of Ukraine*] (VVR), 2003, No. 40 – 44, page 356):

to add the words “and destruction of such goods” after the words “of intellectual property” in clause 3) of Part 2;

to add the words “or taking and destruction of such materials and tools” after the words “of intellectual property” in clause 4) of Part 2;

II. Final Provisions

1. This Law shall enter into force as from the date of promulgation hereof.

2. Until the rules and regulations issued by agencies of executive power have been brought into conformity with this Law, such rules and regulations shall apply to the extent they are consistent with this Law.
