On Approval of the List of Checkpoints on the Customs Border of Ukraine through which Narcotics, Psychotropic Substances and Precursors are Permitted to be Moved

As amended by Cabinet of Ministers' Resolution No.92 of 18 January 2003

In accordance with paragraph 2 of Article 95 of Ukraine's Customs Code, the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine

resolves:

1. To approve the list of checkpoints on the Customs border of Ukraine through which narcotics, psychotropic substances and precursors are permitted to be moved (the list enclosed).
2. That the Resolution come into force on 1 January 2004 (Clause 3 as amended by Cabinet of Ministers' Resolution No.92 of 18 January 2003).

For automobile transport:

on the border with the Republic of Poland: Yagodyn, Sheghini;

on the border with the Slovakian Republic: Uzhgorod;

on the border with the Hungarian Republic: Chop;

on the border with Romania: Porubne;

on the border with the Republic of Moldova: Mohyliv-Podilsky, Kuchurgan, Reni;

on the border with the Republic of Belarus: Domanove, Novi Yarylovychi;

on the border with the Russian Federation: Bachivsk, Hoptivka, Dovzhansky;

For railway transport:

on the border with the Republic of Poland: Yagodyn, Mostyska-II;

on the border with the Slovakian Republic: Pavlove;

on the border with the Hungarian Republic: Chop, Solovka;

on the border with Romania: Vadul-Siret;

on the border with the Republic of Moldova: Mohyliv-Podilsky, Kuchurgan, Reni;

on the border with the Republic of Belarus: Zabolottia, Hornostayivka;

on the border with the Russian Federation: Kvashyne, Topoli, Zernove, Chervona Mohyla.

For maritime transport: Illichivsk commercial sea port, Mariupol commercial sea port, Odessa commercial sea port, Reni commercial sea port, Sevastopol fishery sea port, Izmayil commercial sea port, Mykolayiv commercial sea port.

For air transport: Boryspil, Hostomel, Dnipropetrovsk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kyiv, Kryvy Rih, Lviv, Mykolayiv, Odessa, Simferopol, Uzhgorod, Kharkiv.
