I have the honour to enclose herewith the text of the Decree of the Federal Ministry of Finance No. 234/1991 Coll., which amends and completes the Decree No. 108/1991 Coll., on Import Surcharge, in the wording of the Decree No 154/1991 Coll..

Decree No. 234/1991 Coll. provides for a further reduction in the rate of the import surcharge from 18 per cent to 15 per cent, with effect from 1 June 1991.

DECREE No. 234

of the Federal Ministry of Finance dated 24 May 1991

which amends and complete the Decree No. 108/1991 Coll., on Amport Surcharge

The Federal Ministry of Finance provides according to par. 58 of the Law No. 194/1988 Coll. concerning the competence of federal central bodies of state administration, as per the Law No. 297/1990 Coll., within the scope of an authorization resulting from the Government Resolution of the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic No. 852 of 3 December 1990, in agreement with the Federal Ministry of Foreign Trade, Federal Ministry for Strategic Planning and State Bank of Czechoslovakia, as follows:

Article I

The Decree No. 108/1991 Coll., on Import Surcharge, in the wording of the Decree No. 154/1991 Coll, shall be amended, as follows:

 The percentage rate of "20 per cent" in par. 2 shall be substituted by that of "15 per cent".

Article II

The Decree comes into force on 1 June 1991.
