Third SessionCORRIGENDUM TO SUMMARY RECORD OF THE FIFTH MEETING

Change the statement made by Mr. Hewitt (Australia) on

Page 2 as follows:

"MR. HEWITT (Australia) said that he considered the remarks made by the Netherlands representative as referring to his observations upon the meaning of "such measures" in paragraph 4 (a) which was the point originally raised by the representative of Southern Rhodesia. The proposal to ask the Working Party "to review the procedure for consultation provided in paragraph 4 (a)" was not in accordance with consultation provided for in that paragraph and amounted, in fact, to a review of the terms of the paragraph itself. He also pointed out that the alternative terms of reference which he had proposed were not based on an interpretation of the paragraph because his alternative proposal merely repeated the exact text of the Article. Interpretations had been proposed by other speakers."

And on Page 5 the statement made by Mr. Hewitt (Australia) also to read as follows:

"MR. HEWITT (Australia) said that the Agreement had not been provisionally applied in respect of the territories of New Guinea and Papua and no action to this end as provided for in paragraph 2 of the Protocol of Provisional Application had been taken. He referred to a difference between the provisions of this paragraph and the text of Article XXVI relating to the application of the Agreement to overseas territories when the Agreement was accepted."
