Addendum

Evolution of Restrictions Since the Entry into  
Force of the Arrangement Regarding International  
Trade in Textiles

Attached are tables showing the evolution of restrictions maintained or introduced by participating countries in the Arrangement.

The tables concerning importing countries have been divided into three sections:

1. Restrictions as originally notified under Article 2:1;
2. Restrictions during the period 1 January 1974-31 December 1977;
3. Restrictions maintained or introduced since 1 January 1978 and notified up to 20 September 1980 showing:
  - (a) measures notified under Article 2:1 which have been continued;
  - (b) agreements or measures under the MFA, and
  - (c) other measures.

The tables concerning exporting countries have been divided into two sections:

1. Restrictions as originally notified under Article 2:1, and
2. Restrictions maintained or introduced since 1 January 1978 and notified up to 20 September 1980.

Included in this addendum are tables related to the European Community. See also supplement to this addendum. For other countries see Addenda 1, 3 and 4.

Special difficulties in presenting a comparative tabulation for the EEC, arising principally from the complexity of pre-GPA arrangements by individual members and the number of countries involved, has resulted in a slightly different presentation here than for other importers. In order to keep the table as concise and readable as possible, detailed information on pre-GPA restriction levels is only shown for items which were covered by agreements in the period 1974-1977. Furthermore, information on restrictions with non-participating countries in the initial GPA period is shown in summarized form. Full information on both itemized restriction levels and arrangements with other non-participants at the time of notification under Article 2(1) may be found in COM.TEX/SB/17.
