## TERRITORIAL APPLICATION OF GATT

## <u>Notification by Australia in Respect</u> of Papua New Guinea

The following communication dated 4 August 1975 has been received from the Australian Permanent Mission accredited to the Office of the United Nations at Geneva:

"The Australian Permanent Mission accredited to the Office of the United Nations at Geneva, on instructions from its authorities, has been asked to deposit with the Director-General the attached certified true copy of a notification to the Secretary-General of the United Nations, on the application of the General Agreement to Papua New Guinea. The original of this document is being deposited with the Secretary-General of the United Nations today."

The aforesaid notification reads as follows:

"<u>WHEREAS</u> the Government of Australia signed the Protocol of Provisional Application of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade on the thirtieth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven; and,

"<u>WHEREAS</u> the Government of Australia may, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2 of the said Protocol make effective the provisional application of the General Agreement in respect of Papua New Guinea; and,

"<u>WHEREAS</u> the Government of Papua New Guinea desires that the General Agreement be provisionally applied within its territory;

"<u>THE GOVERNMENT OF AUSTRALIA</u> hereby <u>DECLARES</u> that the General Agreement shall be provisionally applied to PAPUA NEW GUINEA in accordance with paragraph 2 of the said Protocol."

This notification having been deposited with the Secretary-General of the United Nations on 4 August 1975, Australia's provisional acceptance of the GATT in respect of Fapua New Guinea shall be effective, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2 of the Protocol of Provisional Application on 3 September 1975.
