Addendum

In its Report (1984) (L/5713), adopted by the CONTRACTING PARTIES at their Fortieth Session, the Group on Quantitative Restrictions and Other Non-Tariff Measures recommended that the documentation on quantitative restrictions be kept up-to-date on a regular basis (paragraph 44(a)).
