DRAFT CHARTER

COLOMBIA: PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Article 4

Fair Labour Standards

Each member, recognizing that all countries have a common interest in the achievement and maintenance of fair labour standards related to productivity, shall take whatever action may be appropriate and feasible to eliminate sub-standard conditions of labour in production for export and generally throughout its territory. Members which are also members of the International Labour Organization shall co-operate with the organization in giving effect to this undertaking. In the event of low costs of production of any particular product in the territory of any member country, due to unfair conditions of labour, causing or threatening to cause a competition prejudicial to other members, the Organization, at the request of any interested member, shall promptly investigate either directly or through the International Labour Organization, or in collaboration with that organization, and shall recommend whatever measures it may find necessary for a full compliance with this undertaking.
