Corrigendum to the Summary Record  
of the Second Meeting

- 1) The last three lines on page 4 and first 7 lines on page 5 should read as follows:

"Mr. AUGENTHALER said that the question raised by item 16 dealt with former Japanese Islands administered by the United States according to the agreement with the Trusteeship Council. The Charter of the United Nations Organization provides that all Members of the United Nations should be treated equally in trusteeship territories but in this agreement a special position was created in favour of US-administering authority for, - as the United States delegate at the Security Council declared - strategic reasons. If it is so, the matter should be dealt with by the Security Council and not by the Contracting Parties which are competent only in economic matters.

- 2) On page 5, line 2 of Mr. STINEBOWER's remarks, insert after the word "treatment" the words "for Continental United States".
