The twelfth and thirteenth lines of Mr. JHA's (India) statement should read:

"seemed no reason why a bolder attack should not be made on discrimination within the soft currency area. Much progress had been made since the bilateral belancing ..."

The fourth sentence from the end of the same statement should read:
