## Publication and Application by Acceding Governments of Results of Tariff Negotiations

The following is a summary of the replies received to inquiries addressed to the representative of each acceding government as to the date by which that government would be prepared

- 1) to make the results of its negotiations public, and
- 2) to apply them.\*

l. Colombia	Date of submission to next legislature, unless, because of unforeseen circumstances, prior to that date, or later, i.e., 1950 legislature.	Period required for legislature approval and constitutional requirements, i.e., no more than 14 months from date of ratification.
2. Denmark	Date to be agreed by Annecy Conference.	January 1, 1950 (preliminary indication).
3. Dominican Republic	Referred to government for advice.	
4. Finland	Immediately following agree- ment regarding concessions granted in negotiations at Annecy.	
5. Greece		Approximately 6 months from date of signature, i.e. (?) January, 1950.

6.	Haiti	December - 1949	April - 1950
7.	Italy	After submission to Parliament.	After legislative approval or after the legislature gives the government authority to apply the concessions, i.e., (?) January — July 1950.
8.	Liberia	As soon as possible after conclusion of Annecy Conference.	Ninety days from date of publication, i.e., (?) October - 1949.
9•	Nicaragua	No reply received to date.	
10.	Sweden	As soon as government can be informed after conclusion of Annecy Conference subject to agreement by the Con- tracting Parties as to date of publication.	Early 1950 if the Swedish Government is able to submit the agreement to the autumn session of the legislature, if not, July 1950.
11.	Uruguay	Immediately after Annecy Conference, subject to ratification by government.	Unable to indicate a date, which would be determined by legis-lative process.

<sup>\*</sup> All of the replies were received prior to the Executive Secretary's communication of April 21 further explaining his original request, except those of Italy and Uruguay. All the dates mentioned are tentative, and, where preceded by a question mark, represent an attempt to translate the replies into specific dates.
