ACCEPTANCE OF PROTOCOLS

Establishment of a Common Text of the General Agreement

At their Fourth Session the Contracting Parties adopted a resolution inviting all contracting parties to accept each of the protocols which modifies the text of the Agreement if they had not already done, so, so that a uniform text applicable to all contracting parties might be established. These contracting parties were invited to sign or accept all outstanding protocols prior to the opening of the Torquay Conference on 28 September.

The followise is a list of the outstanding protocols together with the names of the contracting parties which, according to information received to date from the Headquarters of the United Mations, have not signed or accepted them:
