DECLARATION CONCERNING THE SIGNATURE OF THE
SIXTH PROTOCOL OF SUPPLEMENTARY CONCESSIONS TO THE
GENERAL AGREEMENT ON TARIFFS AND TRADE

(Adopted by the Tariff Negotiations Committee on 4 May 1956)

CONSIDERING that paragraph 6 of the Sixth Protocol of Supplementary Concessions to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, read in conjunction with paragraph 2 of the said Protocol, provides that the provisions of the Protocol will become effective for each signatory thirty days following the day upon which the Executive Secretary has received from that signatory the notification contemplated in paragraph 2 of the Protocol,

The Governments parties to the Sixth Protocol of Supplementary Concessions to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade

DECLARE that the notification contemplated in paragraph 2 has the same legal effect as the deposit of an instrument of ratification or acceptance contemplated in diplomatic instruments providing for ratification or acceptance and that, consequently, the signature of the Protocol contemplated in sub-paragraph 5(a) of the Protocol has the same legal effect as the signature contemplated in such instruments.
