#### COMMUNICATION FROM SRI LANKA

The following communication dated 29 October 1974 has been received from the Permanent Mission of Sri Lanka.

I have the honour to inform you that my Government has examined the Schedules of Concessions attached to the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries. Only a few products are of interest to Sri Lanka. However, I am forwarding a list of products of export interest to Sri Lanka regarding which it would appear worthwhile to explore possibilities of expanding exports to markets of countries participating in the Arrangement as suggested in paragraph 3(b) of document CPC/S/1 of 3 December 1973.

I shall be glad if relevant information is provided on imports of these items in the participating countries, together with tariff and other regulations applicable. On receipt of this information the Government of Bri Lanka would be in a better position to decide on the feasibility of proceeding to the next stage of compiling "request lists".
