Protocol for the Accession of Bangladesh to the Protocol  
Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries

In the light of a request by the representative of Bangladesh (CPC/66) for an extension of the duration of the Protocol of Accession of Bangladesh, members of the Committee of Participating Countries present at the meeting of 16 March 1983, comprising more than two-thirds of the membership of the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries, adopted the following Decision:

NEGOTIATIONS AMONG DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

Extension of Duration

Decision of 16 March 1983

Considering the request of the Government of Bangladesh for an extension of the duration of its Protocol of Accession to the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries for a further period;

The COMMITTEE OF PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES

Decides in accordance with paragraphs 4 and 14 of the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries to extend the duration of the Protocol of Accession of Bangladesh until 28 March 1986.
