Meeting to be held on 23 September 1983

The Committee of Participating Countries provided for in the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries will hold its thirty-sixth meeting on 23 September 1983, at 10:30 a.m. in the Centre William Rappard, rue de Lausanne 154, Geneva. The meeting will also be open to delegations of countries having signed but not yet ratified the Protocol.

The following items have been proposed for inclusion in the agenda for the meeting:

1. Expansion of trade among developing countries (paragraphs 4-12 of the Summary of Discussions at the last meeting (CPC/70)). At the last meeting, the Committee adopted the Procedures for review of the schedules of concessions circulated in CPC/69. Members of the Committee may wish to review developments and exchange views on matters relevant to this agenda item.
2. Annual report. A draft report for approval by the Committee and transmission to the Committee on Trade and Development will be circulated as CPC/W/99 and addenda.
3. Derestriction of documents. In accordance with the procedures adopted by the Committee on 25 July 1978, a list of documents which would appear to be eligible for derestriction, will be circulated as CPC/W/101.
4. Rotation of officers (CPC/47)
5. Other business
