The Committee of Participating Countries provided for in the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries will hold its thirty-ninth meeting on 18 September 1984, at 3.30 p.m. in the Centre William Rappard, 154 rue de Lausanne, Geneva. The meeting will also be open to delegations of countries having signed but not yet ratified the Protocol.

The following items have been proposed for inclusion in the agenda for the meeting.

1. Expansion of trade among developing countries (paragraphs 3-5 of the Summary of Discussions at the last meeting (CPC/75). Members of the Committee may wish to review developments and exchange views on matters relevant to this agenda item.
2. Annual report. A draft annual report prepared by the secretariat has been circulated as CPC/W/105 and Addenda.
3. Rules of Procedure. (CPC/47). At the last meeting the Committee agreed to revert to the question of possible amendments to the rules of procedure concerning the time period for the service of officers of the Committee at its next meeting (CPC/75 paragraphs 10 and 11).
