Addendum

The secretariat has received the following report under Article 16 of the Agreement on the Implementation of Article VI of the GATT.

CANADA

I have the honour to transmit in accordance with the reporting procedures adopted by the Committee on Anti-Dumping Practices, the following summary of anti-dumping cases in Canada for the period 1 July 1970 to 30 June 1971.

1. Cases pending as of 1 July 1970 (4)
 - Transformers rated above 500 KVA and reactors rated above 500 KVAR from Britain, France, Japan, Sweden, Switzerland, West Germany and Belgium.
 - Glacé cherries originating in France.
 - Women's footwear originating in France, Italy and Spain.
 - Liquid chlorine.

2. Investigations opened 1 July 1970 to 30 June 1971 (12)
 - Electric can openers originating in Japan.
 - Hypodermic single-use needles and syringes originating in the United States and Japan.
 - Ethylene glycol based anti-freeze in bulk originating in the United Kingdom.
 - Monochrome and colour television receiving sets originating in Japan and Taiwan.
 - Standard gypsum wallboard and fire rated gypsum wallboard originating in the United States.
 - Single row tapered roller bearings originating in Japan.
 - Industrial press-on solid rubber tyres.
 - Alternating current high voltage circuit breakers rated 115,000 volts and above, originating in France, Switzerland and Japan.
 - Bicycle tyres and tubes originating in Austria, Japan, the Netherlands, Sweden and Taiwan.

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- Steel EI transformer laminations and steel electrical motor rotor and stator laminations.
 - Apple juice concentrate originating in Austria, Bulgaria, Greece, Hungary and Switzerland.
 - Wedding gowns.

 - Women's footwear (Italy and Spain).
