#### TABLE OF IMPORT RESTRICTIONS

(Chapters 25-99)

Attached herewith is a revision of the consolidated table which was prepared by the secretariat on Chapters 25-99 following the April meeting of the Joint Working Group, now incorporating correction of errors and changes up to 31 October 1970. The notes on individual items have also been revised and modifications to COM.IND/W/28/Add.l are being circulated as COM.IND/W/28/Add.l/Corr.l. When approved by the Group, this material will be issued in final form as part of Annex I to the Group's report (L/3391).

The secretariat wishes to draw attention to one anomaly at present inherent in this documentation. Although the Joint Working Group originally set out to examine all import restrictions maintained by the countries covered in this exercise, it was decided at the meeting to delete those restrictions on products in Chapters 25-99 which were maintained on health and sanitary grounds (L/3391, paragraph 8). Cotton textile restrictions were set aside to a separate annex but were not deleted. Restrictions justified on security grounds were treated still differently, being retained in the list in principle, but with certain items of armament deleted on an ad hoc basis in the course of the Group's work. If this compilation is to become a continuing compendium of restrictions in effect, it would appear desirable to agree on a more consistent coverage.

### INTRODUCTORY NOTE TO ANNEXES I-V

## Import Restrictions Maintained by Specified Countries (Chapters 25-99)

The attached consolidated table of import restrictions on products in Chapters 25-99 of the Brussels Tariff Nomenclature, together with the material in Annexes II and V, brings the statement of restrictions in force up to date through October 1970 to the extent that restrictions maintained by the specified countries have been notified to the contracting parties in one context or another.

Country coverage. Notified restrictions of eighteen contracting parties are included in this table including, in principle, restrictions maintained in non-metropolitan customs territories for which a contracting party has accepted responsibility and discriminatory restrictions applied only against one or a few countries. The coverage is, however, believed to be incomplete especially with regard to the areas just mentioned. Many restrictions of dependent territories and many special arrangements applicable in metropolitan territories to the goods of particular countries are not included.

Types of restriction included. This Annex and Annexes II and V include all of the types of restrictions considered by some members of the Group to constitute import restrictions, as discussed in paragraph 10 of the Group's report, except (with respect to Chapters 25-99) measures maintained on health and sanitary grounds, as stated in paragraph 8 of the report.

Symbols. The symbols used in the table are as follows:

- BQ Bilateral quota this symbol is used where an individual country quota of a fixed amount has been agreed with the supplier country.
- GQ Global quota use of this symbol is confined to restrictions applicable to goods of most if not all countries of origin, where the amount of the quota is published.
- P Prohibition
- ST State trading

(an additional symbol indicates what degree of restriction was considered to be involved in its operation, where attention was given to this matter)

- AL Automatic licensing
- LL Liberal licensing

- DL Discretionary licensing includes cases in which global quotas may have been set but are not published.
- SUSP (followed by country abbreviation) an import restriction has been suspended pending application of an export restraint by the country named in parentheses.
- XR (followed by country abbreviation) the country in brackets operates an export restraint vis-à-vis the country shown as maintaining this restriction.

Certain other restrictions (notably mixing regulations and screen quotas) are mentioned in individual boxes.

The following country or area symbols are used:

(BEL) indicates that the restriction is applied only by Belgium-Luxenbourg.

Elsewhere a country abbreviation in parentheses indicates that the restriction indicated applied only to the country or area named.

A dash preceding an abbreviation indicates that the restriction applies to the countries or areas except that named.

Numbers in the lower left-hand corner of boxes refer to NTB inventory cards.

Symbols in the lower right-hand corner indicate:

- A date has been mentioned as the envisaged time of liberalization.
- B The debate indicated, in the secretariat view, that consideration of joint action looking toward removal or relaxation of restrictions might be fruitful.
- C Products in which developing countries in the Joint Working Group expressed specific interest in regard to the relaxation or elimination of restrictions maintained by consulting countries.
- Dor E Denotes restriction is on one of twenty-one product groups selected by the Group on Residual Restrictions at its meeting in April 1969 for priority attention.

Those marked "D" relate to six of these twenty-one product groups discussed in the Group on Residual Restrictions in November 1969. Information supplied by governments and other relevant background data and statistics compiled by the secretariat on restrictions related to these items are included in COM.TD/70, COM.TD/W/105 and COM.TD/W/107 and their addends and corrigends.

Where the symbol B is used no indication of date of relaxation has been made.

The symbol "E" indicates the remaining fifteen product groups selected by the Group on Residual Restrictions but n t yet examined. Pata on these fifteen product groups, compiled by the secretariat, have been circulated in COM.TD/W/ll8.

As asterisk in the BTN column indicates that the item is of export interest to developing countries (cf. COM.TD/67 and corrigenda).
