DATA ON COMMERCIAL POLICY MEASURES APPLIED BY INDUSTRIALIZED GATT COUNTRIES ON PRODUCTS NOTIFIED BY LECS-DEVELOPED COUNTRIES AS BEING OF SPECIAL EXPORT INTEREST TO THEM

It will be recalled that Committee III had identified approximately eighty tariff items, in terms of the Brussels Tariff Nomenclature, as being of particular export interest to less-developed countries. In addition to these products, included in the first three lists drawn up by the Committee, less-developed countries have notified a further number of products - approximately 170 tariff items - as being of export interest to them. Data on import treatment in respect of all the products notified to Committee III as being of export interest to less-developed countries were circulated to contracting parties in document COM.III/136, dated November 1964. In view of further notifications received by the secretariat regarding changes in import treatment for those products, it has been thought useful to bring this document up to date.¹

It will also be recalled that the secretariat has circulated, in the context of the work arising under the new Part IV of the General Agreement, data on trade flows and import treatment in respect of seventy-nine tariff items which had earlier been selected by less-developed countries for priority study from the more comprehensive list of 170 tariff items notified to Committee III referred to above. This data (document TD/W.1 and addenda) will shortly be taken up for appropriate examination by the Committee.

In the present paper, which is being circulated for general information only, data relating to quantitative restrictions are set out in Section I, customs tariff data in Section II, and data relating to internal changes on certain tropical products in Section III.
