ACTION BY GOVERNMENTS RELEVANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PART IV

Addendum

The following notification on the implementation of Part IV has been received from the Government of Pakistan and should be included in Annex II of COM.TD/60.

The Government of Pakistan has already taken the following actions in terms of paragraph 4 of Article XXXVII of the GATT for the benefit of the trade of the other developing countries:

- 1. It is actively participating in trade negotiations with other developing countries within the framework of the Committee on Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries.
- 2. It has concluded a goodwill trade agreement with the Republic of Korea and has signed a Protocol under an existing trade agreement with Ceylon.
- 3. A Tripartite Agreement between Pakistan, Turkey and Iran was signed on 3 September 1968, which provides inter alia for grant to each other, on the basis of full reciprocity, the benefit of the most-favoured-nation treatment with respect to customs and other duties imposed on import and export of goods.

In terms of these agreements, the Government of Pakistan shall take all appropriate measures to expand and diversify its trade with developing countries in general, and these countries in particular.
