# GENERAL AGREEMENT ON <br> TARIFFS AND TRADE

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EUSTRIE - SPECISL TARIFF MEASURES ON HAND-MADE PRODUCTS
Notification by Eustria

With reference to the implementation of Part IV of the General agreement, the delegation of kustria has notified as follows the tariff measures which Austria has taken recently in order to facilitate the importation of hand-made products.

Quite recently a major step forward has been taken by dustria in the practical implementation of the "Law concerning Imports of Hand-made Products duty-free or at reduced rates of duty with the aim of Promoting Trade Relations with Deveioping Countries" (Eustrian Legal Gazette No. 94/1972).

A Decree has been issued on 25 Septemoer 1974 (Austrian Legal Gazette No. 626,1974) providing for duty-free entry of hand -made items falling within a list of some ninety tariff lines annexed to that Decree. Hand-made textile products falling within another list of some thirty-five tariff lines are admitted at tariff rates reduced by 50 per cent. It may, however, be recalled that according to the Law the handicraft products have to be shipped directly to Austria from the country of origin.

In the preparation of these two lists of tariff lines the frequently identical wishes expressed by some thirty developing countries were taken into account. Those developing countries which - despite an Austrian invitation .- have not submitted lists of handicraft products will nevertheless be able to benefit from the fustrian measure.

In order to be able to make practical use of the tariff advantages it is necessary for all interested developing countries to formally agree with the austrian authorities on the form and substance of certisicates of orizin and of manual

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production of goods as well as on certifying agencies. a draft of such an agreement as well as a sample of the certificate to be used have been transmitted to all developing countries either through their diplomatic representations in Vienna or via the competent fustrian Embassy.

It is hoped that a great number of developing countries will conclude such formal administrative arrangements with eustria in order to take advantage of the increased export possibilities for handicraft products.

Together with the second major step in the Austrian Scheme of Generalized Preferences which came into force on I January 1975 the measure benefiting handicraft products in particular is a contribution to the implementation of the aims of Part IV of GeIT.

## Notes to Annexes A and B

The product descriptions at the level of the four-digit headings are those of the Brussels Tariff Nomenclature. In cases where sub-headings or ex-positions are incorporated in the above annexes, the descriptions bave been given in accordance with the structure of the Austrian Customs Tariff. With a view to facilitating the understanding of this notification, particularly in cases where the description of products is limited to "Other", the following notes indicate the scope of the respective items.
