Addendum

The following notification transmitted by the Government of Denmark should be added to the information contained in Annex I of COM.TD/W/105.

HONEY (04.06)

A global quota of DKr 3.5 million (US\$470,000) has been fixed for imports of natural honey into Denmark. This quota is open for all countries.

Imports in 1967 of natural honey amounted to 1,604 metric tons at a total value of DKr 2,876,000 (US\$409,000). Out of this quantity 1,209 tons amounting to DKr 2,165,000 (US\$308,000) were imported from the developing countries, thereby raising the less-developed countries' share to 75 per cent of total imports.

The Danish Government regrets not to be able to consider a further liberalization of imports of natural honey in view of the need to ensure efficient pollination of plants and trees necessary in the seed and fruit production.
