INFORMATION ON PRODUCTS SELECTED FOR EXAMINATION

Note by the Secretariat

- 1. At its April 1969 meeting the Group on Residual Restrictions discussed restrictions maintained under each of twenty-five product headings listed in document COM.TD/W/93. Statistics on imports of these items into countries maintaining restrictions were circulated in COM.TD/W/95.
- 2. The Group decided at the same meeting to select from the larger list of restricted items the following twenty-one products or product categories for priority examination: natural honey, cut flowers, potatoes, tomatoes, onions, citrus fruit, apples, pears and peaches, mclasses, citrus juices, wine, ethyl alcohol, fishmeal, bran, cigars and cigarillos, menthol, leather and leather products, yarn, fabrics and garments of non-cotton fibres, coir mats and matting and footwear made of leather.
- 3. Six of these twenty-one products, namely: natural honey, fishmeal, cigars and cigarillos, leather and leather products, leather footwear and coir mats and matting were examined by the Group at its meeting held in November 1969. Data on trade measures and trade flows supplied by governments, supplemented by statistics compiled by the secretariat, relating to the six items are contained in documents CCM.TD/W/105 and Addenda 1-3 and COM.TD/W/107 and in the report on the Group's meeting, document COM.TD/70.
- 4. The secretariat has compiled similar information relating to the remaining fifteen products or product groups selected for priority examination. This material is annexed hereto.
- 5. Import restrictions applied by certain developed countries covering some 155 BTN tariff items or sub-items (excluding cotton textiles) notified as being of export interest to developing countries are listed in document COM.TD/67 and Corrigendum 2.
