# GENERAL AGREEMENT ON <br> TARIFFS AND TRADE 

Addendum

The following communication dated 19 October 1979 has been received from the delegation of Japan in connerion with the implementation of Part IV.

> MODIFICATIONS MADE TO JAPAN'S $\frac{\text { GENERALIZFD SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES }}{(F Y 1979)}$

## 1. List of beneficiaries

Guam, the Trust Territories of the Pacific Islonds (including the Northern Mariana Islands), the United States Virgin Islands and American Samoa have been added to the Iist of beneficiaries of Japan's Scheme of Preferences, thus bringing their total number to 145.
2. Positive list of agricultural products (CCCN 1-24)
(1) The following two items have been newly added to the list of agricultural products eligible for preferential treatment:

When calculated on CCCN's four-digit basis, however, the total number of agricultural products eligible for preferential treatment has remained seventy-five, the same level as in the previous year.
(2) No reduction has been made in the current fiscal year with regard to the preferential rates of daty of those items already covered by the Scheme of Preferences.

## 3. Ceiling control of incustrial products (CCCN 25-99)

(1) Former Froduct Group 71, which was previously under monthly control, has been divided into two groujs, one under monthly control and the other under daily control, thus increasing the number of groupings by one, i.e. to a total or 190.
(2) As a result of the above-mentioned division of former Group 71, the number of product groups under daily control has increased by one to the total of forty-one.

Besides, two groups, which were under daily control, have been put under monthly control, aid conversely cwo groups under monthly control put under daily contron, leaving their respective total numbers unehanged. The number of products under monithly control, this, has remained at the previous year's level of 135.
(3) Four groups of products have been nevily placed under flexible application of ceiling control, thus bringing the total number of such product groups to 105. The number of groups of produsts fer which tariff reductions of 50 per cent $f \pm m \mathrm{MFN}$ rates are not applied has also increased by one, i.e. to a total of 123.
(4) Except for those already mentioned in paragraphs (1)-(3) above, no modification has been mace with regard to industrial products: no change to the respective lists of products subject to prior allotment, of selected prociuctis which are subject to 50 per cent reductions from MFN rates, and of products excluded from the Scheme of Preferences.

Note: Reference is made to Annex I for detailed information on the modifications stated in paragraphs (1)-(3) above, and also to Annex II on ceiling quotas, control formulas, etc., for FY 1979 with regard to each individual product group.

## 4. Rules of Origin

No change has been made in the current fiscal year to the Rules of Origin and the Donor Country Content Rule.
