Introduction

1. Under the work programme of GATT adopted after the conclusion of the Tokyo Round in 1979, the Committee on Trade and Development was given a task to work on further trade liberalization in areas identified as being of special interest to developing countries, which included notably tropical products. In this connexion, the secretariat provided during 1981 detailed data on the commercial policy situation and trade flows with respect to a number of tropical products. Data for coffee and coffee products were circulated as COM.TD/W/328 and Add.1, and these documents were used as background material for the Consultations on Trade Liberalization (tropical products) held in March 1982.
2. The CONTRACTING PARTIES, meeting at the Ministerial level in November 1982, decided "to carry out, on the basis of the work programme pursued by the Committee on Trade and Development, consultations and appropriate negotiations aimed at further liberalization of trade in tropical products, including in their processed and semi-processed forms, and to review the progress achieved in eliminating or reducing existing obstacles to trade in tropical products at their 1984 Session." At its meeting on 8 March 1983, the Committee on Trade and Development agreed that the background documentation prepared for the 1982 Consultations on Trade Liberalization would be updated, for the purpose of carrying out the consultations and appropriate negotiations called for by the Ministers.
3. This addendum updates information on certain commercial policy measures, trade flows, prices and consumption in COM.TD/W/328, taking into account discussions in the 1982 Consultations on tropical products. Tables in Annex 1 show developments in the exports and imports (value and quantity) of coffee and coffee products over the coffee years 1971/72-1980/81. Also, Annex 2 updates the tariff and trade flow data at the tariff line level previously circulated as Annex 2 to COM.TD/W/328. Annex 2 covers EEC, Japan, Norway, Sweden, Switzerland and the United States. Up-dated tariff and trade flow data for certain other developed countries will be circulated later as they become available.

Commercial policy situation (see also SECTION II in COM.TD/W/328)

4. Table 1 on the next page, which shows the post-Tokyo Round tariff and non-tariff measure situation, updates Table 1 in COM.TD/W/328 on the basis of information provided in the 1982 Consultations, available information on changes made in commercial policy measures and data on the incidences of specific duties obtained on the basis of 1980 imports. Tariff incidences shown in the updated table are often higher than those shown previously, reflecting a significant decline in coffee prices in 1980 compared with those in 1977.
5. Recent changes in commercial policy measures include the following: Austria granted roasted coffee and coffee extracts from least-developed countries duty-free treatment, on 1 January 1982. Canada reduced its GSP rate on coffee extracts to zero, on 13 November 1981. Switzerland reduced its m.f.n. duty on coffee extracts from Sw F 2.70/kg to Sw F 2.60/kg. on 1 May 1981. Belgium and Luxembourg introduced new selective taxes on coffee and coffee products on 1 September 1981. A French tax on instant coffee has been suspended.

Selective internal taxes

6. Internal taxes imposed specifically on such tropical products as coffee, cocoa, tea and bananas are a legacy of the time when these products had been considered as "easily taxable luxury items". Such taxes have been gradually reduced or removed by, or have become less important as revenue sources in, a number of developed countries as these tropical products become ordinary consumer goods, and as general internal taxes such as the value-added tax become increasingly important as revenue sources.

7. Selective taxes on tropical products have drawn particular attention in the work of GATT for developing countries since 1959. A report of Committee III in 1959 stated that "in regard to coffee, tea and cocoa, the taxes impinge exclusively on imports from the less-developed countries as there is no domestic production in the country imposing the taxes" (BISD, Eighth Supplement, page 138). The Ministerial Declaration of 1961 stated that "fiscal charges, whether imposed as tariff duties or internal taxes may inhibit efforts directed towards increasing consumption of particular products important in the trade of less-developed countries and, even where applied equally to imports and to competing domestic products, can be a serious obstacle to the expansion of trade" (BISD Tenth Supplement, page 30). One of the results of the GATT activities in this area was the adoption of the provisions of GATT Article XXXVII:1(c) in Part IV with respect to "fiscal measures which would hamper, or which hamper, significantly the growth of consumption of primary products, in raw or processed form wholly or mainly produced in the territories of less-developed contracting parties, and which are applied specifically to those products". Having regard to these GATT provisions and their other international commitments, certain countries have refrained from increasing the rates of their taxes on coffee and tea in spite of proposals to do so for fiscal reasons.

8. As far as coffee is concerned, selective internal taxes remain in Belgium¹, Luxembourg¹, Denmark, Germany F.R., Italy and Japan. Those of the first five countries are specific rates. The rates of these taxes, as well as ad valorem incidences of specific rates on c.i.f. value, are indicated below.

9. The ad valorem incidences of specific rates indicated above have been obtained on the basis of the average import unit value of the country concerned in 1981. By nature of a specific rate, its incidence increases when import prices in terms of the currency of the country concerned decrease, and vice versa. Such import prices have fluctuated in recent years as a result of fluctuations in coffee prices on the world market and in currency exchange rates. For example, reduced coffee prices as well as revaluations of a currency bring about increases in the incidence of a specific tax rate, as was the case in certain countries in recent years. It may be noted that the incidence varies also according to the type and quality of imported coffee.

14. In the countries listed above, coffee retail prices in 1976 increased between 8 to 32 per cent as compared with 1975. While coffee consumption continued to grow in some of these countries, it stagnated or decreased in others. A sharper increase in coffee retail prices in 1977 resulted in a significant decline in coffee consumption in 1977 and/or 1978 in a number of markets, in particular those where per capita coffee consumption is already at a high level and has a long-term tendency to decline or stagnate. Price decreases in the ensuing years have helped to recover or increase consumption in a number of markets, in particular those where per capita coffee consumption has a long-term tendency to increase. While coffee consumers might not react to unnoticeable minor changes in retail prices, it would appear that they react to noticeable significant price changes.

15. A report on the United States market submitted by the International Coffee Organization in 1980 shows that coffee as a beverage item competes primarily with soft drinks, milk, juices and tea in the market. While soft drinks, juices and tea have been increasing their share of the beverage market in recent years, coffee and milk, in particular the former, have been losing theirs. In a number of markets there is a tendency for the population to diversify beverage items, often at the expense of traditional drinks, e.g. tea in the United Kingdom, coffee in the Nordic countries and the United States and green tea in Japan. Among factors affecting the competition between different beverage items are relative prices and changes in consumer tastes.

16. Table 2 in this document updates Table 3 in COM.TD/W/328 showing developments in coffee prices and per capita consumption in major consuming countries.
