QUANTITATIVE IMPORT RESTRICTIONS ON PRODUCTS NOTIFIED AS BEING OF EXPORT INTEREST TO LESS-DEVELOPED COUNTRIES

Secretariat Note

As its meeting in June, the Group on Residual Restrictions also had before it, in document COM.TD/7, summary information on the import treatment of products which had earlier been notified as being of export interest to less-developed countries.

For information of the Group, and to facilitate its work, the secretariat has excerpted from document COM.TD/7, and brought up-to-date, the information relating to quantitative restrictions affecting products notified earlier to Committee III, or to the Committee on Trade and Development.

Also attached to this paper is the full list of items notified to Committee III, the Committee on Trade and Development and in the context of the Kennedy Round negotiations as being of export interest to less-developed countries.

"L", "l"	denotes licensing requirement but imports
