ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notifications under Article 2, Paragraph 1

Attached is a notification received by the TSB from NORWAY in accordance with paragraph 1 of Article 2 of the Textiles Arrangement. As required by the provisions of this paragraph the TSB is circulating this notification to participating countries in the Arrangement for their information. A summary tabulation of this notification prepared by the secretariat is also attached.

It is to be noted that the TSB, in the light of paragraph 11 of COM.TEX/2, is continuing to examine the potifications received in order to ensure the completeness and adequacy of the information, and is requesting the supply of additional information wherever necessary. Any additional information thus received will also be circulated.

It is, of course, open to any party to the Arrangement to request the TSB or the secretariat to seek any further information or clarification they may wish to have from the parties concerned, or to supply any additions information of relevance. Such information will also be circulated.

Quantitative Restrictions and Bilateral Agreements in Force as of April 1974

Japan

Negotiations for a renewal of the agreement between Norway and Japan have not yet been concluded. The latest agreement covered the period 1 October 1972-30 September 1973. The agreement comprises quotas for the following textile products:

Republic of Korea

Negotiations for a renewal of the agreement between Norway and Korea will take place in June. The latest agreement includes the following quotas for a twelve-month period:

Textiles falling within the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles	US\$155,000

The items subject to regulation are the same as from Japan. Textiles and garments not falling under these BTN positions can be imported without limitation.

Hong Kongl

The agreement between Norway and Hong Kong covers the period 1 March 1973-30 June 1974 and is based on export restraints. The agreement will be notified by Hong Kong.

Malaysia

The Norwegian agreement with Malaysia is based on export restraints and comprises woven shirts. The agreement covers the period 1 May 1973-30 April 1975. The agreed limit is 210,000 shirts for the first year and a 5 per cent increase for the second year.

Singapore

The latest agreement between Norway and Singapore was based on export restraints and comprised shirts of synthetic fibres. The agreement covered the period 1 January 1972-31 December 1973. The restraint limit was 105,000 shirts for the first year with 5 per cent increase for the second year. Until a new agreement has been concluded, the imports of woven shirts from Singapore will be subject to quantitative restrictions.

Bulgaria

Negotiations for a renewal of the agreement between Norway and Bulgaria took place in March. The agreement for 1974 includes:

A total quota (\$150,000) for textile goods (including ready-made clothing and hosiery) of cotton, linen and wool. None of the products shall exceed 25 per cent of the total quota and towels not more than \$15,000 (\$1 = NKr 6).

Letter No. 2

24 April-1974

I have the honour to transmit herewith, on instructions from the Hong Kong authorities, a notification, in accordance with the provisions of Article 2.1 of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles, of restraints applied by Hong Kong to exports of certain textile apparel items to Norway.

I also enclose a copy of the text of the relevant agreement, being a Memorandum of Understanding signed at Hong Kong on 15 March 1973 between the Director of Commerce and Industry for the Government of Hong Kong and the Consul-General for the Covernment of Norway.

Please accept, Sir, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Introduction

- 1. This Memorandum of Understanding sets out the arrangements that have been agreed between the Governments of Hong Kong and of Norway regarding the limits that the Government of Hong Kong are to apply to exports of certain garments for importation into Norway.
- 2. In reaching agreement on these arrangements, both Governments have had regard to the provisions of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles, in particular to Article 4 of that Arrangement, and to the provisions of Article XXII(1) of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade.

Coverage

3. These arrangements apply to Hong Kong's exports to Norway of the items listed in the Annex to this Memorandum.

Restraint period

4. These arrangements will apply from 1 March 1973 to 30 June 1974.

Restraint limits

- 5. The Hong Kong Government will restrict exports to the category limits listed in column (c) of the Annex, save as provided for in paragraphs 7 and 8.
- 6. The Government of Norway will not admit imports of the garments of Hong Kong origin listed in the Annex unless such imports are covered by a Hong Kong export licence endorsed by the Commerce and Industry Department, Hong Kong, that the consignments concerned have been debited to the agreed limits.

Swing

7. Exports may exceed the limits for any category by not more than 10 per cent; provided that corresponding reductions are applied in other categories. For the purpose of calculating such corresponding reductions, the conversion factors listed in column (d) of the Annex shall apply.

Carry-over

8. If, at the end of the period covered by the Arrangements expiring on 28 February 1973 exports from Hong Kong to Norway are less than the basic restraint limits for that period specified in the enclosure to the Commerce and

Industry Department's Memorandum, of 23 November 1972, to the Royal Norwegian Consulate General, Hong Kong may export amounts equivalent to such shortfalls during the period covered by this Memorandum provided that such exports:

- (i) are in the categories where the shortfalls occurred;
- (ii) do not exceed 10 per cent of the restraint limits specified in column (c) of the enclosure to the Commerce and Industry Department's Memorandum of 23 November 1972 to the Royal Norwegian Consulate General.

Re-exports

9. The Government of Norway will, so far as possible, inform the Hong Kong Government when imports into Norway of garments that have been debited to the agreed limits are subsequently re-exported from Norway. The Hong Kong Government may then credit the quantities involved to the appropriate limits.

Exchange of statistics

- 10. The Hong Kong Government will provide the Government of Norway with fortnightly statistics of exports of the garments listed in the Annex licensed for export to Norway and debited to the quantities set out in column (c) of the Annex.
- 11. The Government of Norway will, so far as possible, provide the Hong Kong Government with quarterly statistics of total imports and of imports from other significant suppliers of each of the items listed in the Annex.

Consultation

- 12. The Governments of Norway and Hong Kong agree to consult together, at the request of either party, on any matter arising from the implementation of these arrangements.
- 13. If the Hong Kong Government consider that, as a result of the restraint imposed by these arrangements, Hong Kong is being placed in an inequitable position vis-à-vis a third country, the Hong Kong Government may request the Government of Norway to consult with a view to appropriate remedial action such as a reasonable modification of these arrangements.

ANNEX

Note by the Chairman of the Textiles Surveillance Body

Clarification of Certain Points Riased by the TSB

In the course of the review by the TSB of the Norwegian notification, the following questions were raised:

- 1. Has Norway, after the expiry of its agreement with Japan, imposed restrictions unilaterally?
- 2. If the levels of restraints with respect to Korea could be provided?
- 3. If the text of bilateral agreements could be made available?

The secretariat was asked to seek the necessary clarifications. The following replies have been received from Norway:

Norway has not, after expiry of its agreement with Japan, imposed quantitative restrictions unilaterally, but has continued to issue import licenses for the goods covered by the agreement as if the agreement had been extended. This has been done on the basis of mutual understanding between the two parties.

The agreement is in the process of being renewed.

2. Negotiations for a renewal of the agreement between Norway and Korea took place on 24 May. According to the agreement reached the following restraint levels shall be applied for the importation of textile goods from Korea in the period 1 January to 31 December 1974.

Fabrics

US dollars 385,000

Other textile articles US dollars 415,000 (limited to \$75,000 per item) and garments

The import licences will be issued on the basis of Korean export recommendations.

3. The texts of the bilateral agreements have been regarded as confidential between the two countries. However, steps are now being taken to have them derestricted and, as soon as this process is terminated, the texts will be notified.
