As required by the provisions of this paragraph the TSB is circulating this notification to participating countries in the Arrangement for their information. A summary tabulation of this notification prepared by the secretariat is also attached.

It is to be noted that the TSB, in the light of paragraph 11 of COM.TEX/2, is continuing to examine the notifications received in order to ensure the completeness and adequacy of the information, and is requesting the supply of additional information wherever necessary. Any additional information thus received will also be circulated.

It is, of course, open to any party to the Arrangement to request the TSB or the secretariat to seek any further information or clarification they may wish to have from the parties concerned, or to supply any additional information of relevance. Such information will also be circulated.

ANNEX

Note by the Chairman of the Textiles Surveillance Body Clarification of Certain Points Raised by the TSB

In the course of the review by the TSB of the Austrian notification, the following questions were raised:

- 1. What is the country coverage of the global quota established for certain Far Eastern countries (page 3, II(d)).
- 2. Whether the effective date of entry of the restriction shown as 1 January 1974, refers to new restrictions introduced during this year, or to previously existing restrictions which have been renewed for the year 1974.

In addition the point was made that hand-made carpets are included as subject to restrictions, though in terms of paragraph 3 of Article 12, hand-made textile products are outside the purview of the Arrangement subject to the proviso therein.

The secretariat was, therefore, asked to seek the necessary clarification. This was done, and the following sets out the replies given:

- 1. The countries covered by the global quotas are the Philippines, Thailand, Taiwan, North Vietnam, North Korea, Laos and Mongolia. In the case of North Vietnam, North Korea, Laos and Mongolia, there are hardly any imports.
- 2. The explanation as to the effective date of the restrictions shown as 1 January 1974, is as follows:
 - Egypt A new bilateral agreement negotiated under Article 4 of the Textiles Arrangement, and will be notified in accordance with this Article to the TSB.
 - India, Korea, Pakistan and Japan There were bilateral agreements concluded under the LTA with these countries. These, however, expired on 30 September 1973, and the restrictions fixed thereunder will continue pending negotiations with the countries concerned.
 - Bulgaria, Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Poland and Romania These restrictions were negotiated during the year 1973 in the framework of trade agreements for the year 1974.
 - Philippines, Thailand, Taiwan, North Vietnam, North Korea, Laos and Mongolia These are unilateral import restrictions imposed by Austria for many years; the levels listed applying to the year 1974.

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3. On the question of hand-made carpets it was confirmed that in any new agreement, the hand-made carpets of the cottage industry, as well as the traditional folklore products, will be exempted from any restrictions, subject, of course, to the certification procedure provided for in paragraph 3 of Article 12.
