ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Report on Status of Restrictive Measures Under Article 2, Paragraph 4

Note by the Chairman

The Textiles Surveillance Body has received from the Government of CANADA a report on the status of the restrictive measures originally notified by it in document COM.TEX/SB/2. This report has been submitted to the TSB in accordance with Article 2, paragraph 4, of the Arrangement.

The TSB noted that during the currency of the Arrangement Canada had extended, because of special circumstances existing at the time, the duration of the restrictions on imports of shirts under Article XIX of GATT which had originally been introduced in 1971.¹

The TSB is circulating this notification to participating countries in the Arrangement for their information.
