## UNITED STATES AND THAILAND AMEND TEXTILE AGREEMENT

PRINCIPLE SERVED DE L'ANDRE L'

The United States and Thailand amended their bilateral textile agreement by exchange of notes dated 14 November 1977. The texts of the notes follow.

#### UNITED STATES NOTE

Bangkok, 14 November 1977

### Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Bilateral Agreement on Trade in Cotton, Wool and Man-Made Fiber Textile Products of 29 December 1975, as amended, between our two Governments (hereinafter referred to as the Agreement). I also refer to the letter of 12 October 1977, from Mr. Chumphol Dhamcharee, Director-General, Department of Foreign Trade, Ministry of Commerce, to Mr. Ross C. Parr, First Secretary, Embassy of the United States of America, requesting changes in certain consultation levels for the current Agreement year. Accordingly, I wish to propose the following consultation levels for the second Agreement year:

228	1,179,490

If this proposal is acceptable to the Royal Thai Government, this note and your note of confirmation on behalf of the Royal Thai Government shall constitute an amendment to the Agreement.
