#### ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

### Notification under Articles 7 an 8

#### Amendment to an Interim Bilateral Agreement Between the United States and a Non-Farticipating Country

The Textiles Surveillance Body has received from the United States a notification of an amendment to the Interim Agreement previously concluded between the United States and a non-participating country. This notification has been made in accordance with the decision of the Textiles Committee that actions taken vis-à-vis non-participants in the Arrangement should be notified.

The TSB is circulating this notification to participating countries for their information.

#### UNITED STATES 'ND THE REPUBLIC OF CHIEFA ANEND INTERIM AGREEMENT

The United States and the Depublic of China exchanged notes on 30 March 1978 to amend the existing Interim Agreement between the two countries. The texts of the notes follow:

#### UNITED STATES NOTE

30 March 1978

Excellency:

I have the honour to refer to the Interim Agreement of 16 December 1977 (the "Interim Agreement") between the Government of the Republic of China and the Government of the United States of America concerning trade in cotton, wool and man-made fibre textiles and textile products manufactured in the Republic of China.

I have also the honour to refer to discussions between representatives of the Government of the Republic of China and the Government of the United States of America held in Taipei from 23 to 28 January 1978, and in Washington from 21 to 24 February 1978, concerning exports to the United States of such textiles and textile products. As a result of these discussions I have the honour to propose, on behalf of the Government of the United States of America, that the Interim Agreement be amended as follows:

1. Paragraph 1 of the Interim Agreement is amended to read:

"1. The term of this Interim Agreement shall be from 1 January 1978 through 30 June 1978."

2. Paragraph 5 of the Interim Agreement is amended to read:

"5. Categories not subject to specific limits are subject to consultation levels and to the aggregate and applicable group limits. Except as specified in Annex C, which sets out certain different consultation levels, consultation levels for categories not subject to specific limits shall be 500,000 square yards equivalent for categories in Group I, 350,000 square yards equivalent for categories in Group II, and 50,000 square yards equivalent for categories in Group III."

# 3. Annexes B and C to the Interim Agreement are deleted and are replaced, respectively, by Annexes B and C to this Note.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to your Government, this Note and your Excellency's Note of Acceptance on behalf of the Government of the Republic of China shall constitute an agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Republic of China, amending the Interim Agreement.
