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ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Article 4 Notification

Bilateral Agreement Between Sweden and Hong Kong

The Textiles Surveillance Body has received from Sweden a notification of a new agreement between Sweden and Hong Kong, concerning trade in textiles, for the period 1 April 1979 to 31 March 1981.^{1/} This agreement has been notified by Sweden under Article 4, paragraph 4, of the Arrangement.

The TSB, pursuant to its procedure regarding bilateral agreements notified under Article 4^{2/}, has examined the relevant documentation. The TSB is circulating the text of this agreement to participating countries in the Arrangement.^{3/}

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Article 1 - Introduction

- (a) This Memorandum of Understanding sets out the arrangements made between the Government of Hong Kong and the Government of Sweden that the Government of Hong Kong shall apply to exports of certain textiles for importation into Sweden.
- (b) These arrangements have been made having regard to the renewed Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles bearing in mind particularly the provisions of Article 1 and Article 4 of the said Arrangement and the document known as COM.TEX/W/47.

Article 2 - Coverage

- (a) These arrangements apply to exports from Hong Kong to Sweden of the textile products described in Annex I hereof (being products which derive their chief characteristics from their textile components) of cotton, wool or man-made fibres or any blend containing one or more of those fibres in which either wool represents 17 per cent or more by weight, or any or all of those fibres in combination represent 50 per cent or more by weight of the product.
- (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Article these arrangements shall also apply to woven outerwear, and to the knitted outerwear covered by Groups VI, VII, VIII, IX, XII, XIII, XIV and XVII and by the Export Authorization system, which are manufactured from impregnated fabrics as defined in Annex II of these arrangements.

Article 3 - Restraint Periods

The Government of Hong Kong shall, for the two periods 1 April 1979 to 31 March 1980 and 1 April 1980 to 31 March 1981, limit exports to Sweden of the products listed in Annex I hereof to the Aggregate limit for each period being 52,607,505 equivalent square yards for the first period and 52,650,000 equivalent square yards for the second period and to the specific Group limits for each period set out therein, subject to the provisions of Article 4 of these arrangements.

Article 4 - Flexibility Provisions

In addition to the flexibility incorporated in the Groups and in the specific Group limits in Annex I hereof the following provisions shall apply.

- (a) If in the period 1 January 1978 to 31 March 1979 exports from Hong Kong to Sweden of the products covered by the Memorandum of Understanding of 19 January 1979, as adjusted to annual levels, are less than the corresponding notional annual levels specified in column (e) of the Annex thereto, the Government of Hong Kong may, after consultation with the Government of Sweden, during the period 1 April 1979 to 31 March 1980 approve the export of additional amounts equivalent to such shortfalls provided that such exports -
 - (i) are in the same Groups where the shortfalls occurred;
 - (ii) do not exceed 5 per cent of the notional annual levels of these Groups specified in the Memorandum of Understanding of 19 January 1979.
- (b) If in the period 1 April 1979 to 31 March 1980 exports from Hong Kong to Sweden of the products covered by specific Group limits in Annex I to this Memorandum are less than the corresponding limits specified in column (f) of that Annex, the Government of Hong Kong may, after consultation with the Government of Sweden, for the period 1 April 1980 to 31 March 1981 approve the export of additional amounts equivalent to such shortfalls provided that such exports -
 - (i) are in the same specific Groups where the shortfalls occurred;
 - (ii) do not exceed 5 per cent of the specific Group limits set out in column (f) of Annex I to this Memorandum.

- (c) If in the period 1 January 1978 to 31 March 1979 exports from Hong Kong to Sweden of the products covered by the Memorandum of Understanding of 19 January 1979 exceed the corresponding levels specified in column (e) of the Annex thereto as a result of carry forward in accordance with paragraph 6 of that Memorandum, the Government of Hong Kong shall inform the Government of Sweden of the carry forward quantities and debit these to the corresponding specific Group limits for the period 1 April 1979 to 31 March 1980 set out in column (f) of Annex I to this Memorandum.
- (d) During the period 1 April 1979 to 31 March 1980 the Government of Hong Kong, after consultation with the Government of Sweden, may approve the export of amounts in excess of the specific Group limits in column (f) of Annex I to this Memorandum up to 2.5 per cent of those limits (carry forward). Where the specific Group limits are increased by carry forward the Government of Hong Kong shall inform the Government of Sweden of the carry forward quantities and debit these to the corresponding specific Group limits for the period 1 April 1980 to 31 March 1981 set out in column (g) of Annex I to this Memorandum.
- (e) During the period 1 April 1980 to 31 March 1981 the Government of Hong Kong, after consultation with the Government of Sweden, may approve the export of amounts in excess of the specific Group limits in column (g) of Annex I to this Memorandum up to 2.5 per cent of those limits (carry forward). Where the specific Group limits are increased by carry forward the Government of Hong Kong shall inform the Government of Sweden of the carry forward quantities and debit these to any corresponding specific Group limits that may be agreed for a subsequent restraint period.

Article 5 - Export Authorization System

- (a) The Government of Hong Kong shall operate an Export Authorization system under which no Export Licence for the products specified as E/A Items in Annex I of these arrangements will be issued unless an Export Authorization has previously been obtained in respect of the products concerned. Export Authorizations are issued only on production of evidence of a firm contract for the supply of the products for which the Export Authorization is required.
- (b) The application for an Export Licence for the particular products for which an Export Authorization is issued must be made before the expiry of the Export Authorization. Export Licences are valid for twenty-eight days. Export Authorizations will be valid for a period of three months. The actual products must therefore be exported within four months from the issue of the Export Authorization.
- (c) The Government of Hong Kong will forward via the Consul-General of Sweden fortnightly returns to the Government of Sweden showing the quantities, in commercial units, covered by Export Authorizations issued to Hong Kong exporters and the quantities, in commercial units and equivalent square yards, as well as in actual kilogram net weight covered by Export Licences issued against Export Authorizations to Hong Kong exporters.
- (d) The Government of Hong Kong will, on request by the Government of Sweden made at any time, discontinue the issue of Export Authorizations for any of the products concerned, such request to be followed within a reasonable period of time by a request for consultations in accordance with the provisions of Article 3, unless otherwise agreed, of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles.

- (e) Should a request be made by the Government of Sweden to discontinue the issue of Export Authorizations the Government of Hong Kong may continue to issue Export Licences for products covered by Export Authorizations issued prior to the receipt of the request.
- (f) If the consultations result in agreement to establish a restraint limit the relevant provisions of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles and the document known as COM.TEX/W/47 shall apply.
- (g) In the event that the issue of Export Authorizations for any products is suspended at the request of the Government of Sweden in accordance with the procedure set out in Paragraph (d) of this Article, the Government of Sweden would be prepared to consider giving its consent to the extension of validity of an existing Export Authorization by a period not exceeding 90 days, if it is satisfied that the failure to apply for an Export Licence within the period of validity of the Export Authorization has been caused by circumstances beyond the control of the person to whom the Export Authorization was issued.

Article 6 - Admission of Imports

The Government of Sweden shall admit imports of the products of Hong Kong origin listed in Annex I hereof provided such imports are covered by a Hong Kong Export Licence endorsed by the Trade Industry and Customs Department, Hong Kong, that the products concerned have been debited to the Aggregate limits, and, where appropriate, the specific Group limits in columns (f) and (g) of Annex I, as they may be modified by application of the provisions of Article 4 of this Memorandum.

Article 7 - Re-exports

Should it come to the attention of the Government of Sweden that textile products subject to these arrangements licensed by the Government of Hong Kong for export to Sweden and debited to the limits set out in Annex I have been imported into Sweden and subsequently re-exported therefrom, the Government of Hong Kong shall be informed and consultations may be requested in accordance with Article 9 of these arrangements.

Article 8 - Exchange of Statistics

- (a) The Government of Hong Kong will provide the Government of Sweden with fortnightly statistics of exports in the Groups and E/A Items listed in Annex I hereof that have been licensed for export to Sweden and debited to the limits set out in the said Annex.
- (b) The Government of Sweden will provide the Government of Hong Kong with quarterly statistics of total imports and imports from other significant suppliers of the Groups and E/A Items listed in Annex I hereof.
- (c) The Government of Hong Kong will provide statistical data of exports of textile products, listed in Annex I hereof, to other markets in such detail as the Government of Sweden may, from time to time, reasonably request.


Article 9 - Consultation

- (a) The Government of Hong Kong and the Government of Sweden agree to consult together, at the request of either Government, on any matter arising from the implementation of these arrangements.
- (b) If the Government of Sweden considers that as a result of the application of these arrangements there is undue concentration of exports or the possibility thereof in any particular product, the Government of Sweden may request the Government of Hong Kong to consult with a view to appropriate remedial action such as a reasonable modification of these arrangements.



ANNEX II

Definition of "Impregnated Fabrics"
for the purposes of Article 2

Fabrics of cotton, wool or man-made fibres or any blend containing one or more of those fibres in which either wool represents 17 per cent or more by weight or any or all of those fibres in combination represent 50 per cent or more by weight of the unfinished fabric shall be defined as "impregnated fabrics" where those fabrics have been impregnated, coated, covered or laminated with preparations of cellulose derivatives or of other artificial plastic materials whatever the nature of the plastic material (compact, foam, sponge or expanded).

2. The definition does not cover -


- (a) Fabrics which, after impregnation, coating, covering or laminating, cannot, without fracturing, be bent manually around a cylinder of a diameter of 7 mm at a temperature between 15° C and 30° C.
- (b) Fabrics either completely embedded in artificial plastic material or coated or covered on both sides with such material.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON SAILS

For the two periods 1 April 1979 to 31 March 1980 and 1 April 1980 to 31 March 1981, exports from Hong Kong to Sweden of sails of man-made fibres (Swedish statistical classification number 62.04 ex 290; Hong Kong statistical classification number 658 291-292) shall be subject to the Export Authorization system provided for in Article 5 of the Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of Hong Kong and the Government of Sweden signed earlier today at Hong Kong.

2. Article 6 of the said Memorandum shall apply to the products covered by this Memorandum but in substitution for the endorsement required by that Article the Export Licences for sails of man-made fibres shall be endorsed "Debited against Export Authorizations for export to Sweden".
3. In respect of sails of man-made fibres, the Government of Sweden undertakes not to invoke the provisions of Paragraph (d) of Article 5 of the Memorandum referred to in the first Paragraph hereof before the level of Export Authorizations in either of the twelve-month periods exceeds 45 metric tons.
