Amendment to the Agreement between the United States and India

I refer to the Agreement between the United States of America and India Relating to Trade in Cotton, Wool, and Man-Made Fibre Textiles and Textile Products, with annexes, effected by exchange of notes 30 December 1977, as amended ("the Agreement"). I also refer to your letter of 31 August 1979 in which you request permission to exceed the consultation level for category 666 for the 1979 Agreement Yeur as follows:

Category	Increase	<u>New Consultation Level</u> (Square Yards Equivalent)
666	625,000	3,125,000

I am pleased to inform you that my Government agrees to this request, and that this letter and your letter shall constitute an amendment to the Agreement.

Embassy of India in the United States presents its compliments to the United States Department of State and has the honour to refer to the Agreement concerning exports to the United States of cotton, wool and manmade fibre textiles and textile products manufactured in India effected by exchange of notes between the two Governments on 30 December 1977.

In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 6 of this Agreement, the Government of India has the honour to inform the Government of the United States that it wishes to export to the United States textile products in excess of the currently applicable consultation level of 2,500,000 Square Yards Equivalent in category 666 in the second Agreement Year. Accordingly the Government of India requests the Government of the United States to increase the applicable consultation level of this category by 625,000 Square Yards Equivalent to 3,125,000.

Embassy of India avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the United States Department of State the assurances of its highest consideration.
