## ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONA: TRADE IN TEXTILES <br> Notification under Article $4: 4$ <br> imendment to the Agreement Between the United States and Pakistan

The Textiles Surveillance Body has received a notificetion from the United States of amendments to its bilateral agreement with Pakistan, concluded under Article 4 of the Arrangement. ${ }^{1}$

The TSB, pursuant to its procedure regardine bilaternl egreements notified under inticle $4 ?$, has exsmined the relevant documentation and is circulating the text of the notification to the participating countries.

[^0]UNITED STATES AND PAKISTAN
AMEND TEXTILE AGREEMGENT
The United States and Pakistan exchanged notes on 7 December 1978 and 25 July 1979 to amend the existing bilateral agreement on trade in cotton textiles and textile products between the two countries. The texts of the notes follow:

UNITED STATES NOTE
7 December 1978
Sir,
I refer to the Arrangement Regarding Internationnl Trade in Textiles (the "Arrangement"), done at Geneva on 20 December 1973 , and extended by protocol opened for signature at Geneva on 15 December 1977, and to the arreem:nt of 4 and 9 Jonuary 2978 (the "Acreement") between the Government of Pakistan and tiae Government of the United States of America; concerning trade in cotton textiles and textile products.

I also refer to discussions between representatives of the Government of Paristan and the Government of the united States of America in Washington on 23 October 1978, concermine exports to the United States of imerica of certain cotton fibre textiles and textile products fiom Pelistan. is a result of these iiscussions I propose, on behaif of the Government of the United States of America, that durine the first Afreement Yes exports from Pahistan to the linited States of imerica of the following cotegories shall not exceed the consuitetion leveis stated below:
