An import licence is required only for the articles listed below:

55.06.01	Bleached or unbleached
55.06.09	Dyed or coloure: 2. Three-ply or more
55.06.91	Bleached
55.06.99	Dyed or coloured
55.07	Cotton gauze
55.08	Terry towelling and similar terry fabrics, of cotton
55.09	Other woven fabrics of cotton
55.09.01	In lengths of less than 2.75 metres (3 yards)
55.09.02	Canvas
