ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Report on the Status of Restrictive Measures as
Requested by the TSB¹ in Accordance
with Article 11, paragraphs 11 and 12

Except custom duties and levies on imports which were in force at the time of our accession to this Arrangement, no restrictions have been imposed. However, import licensing was required for certain items:
