## Amendment to the Agreement between the United States and India

I refer to the Agreement between the United States of America and India Relating to Trade in Cotton, Wool, and Man-Made Fibre Textiles and Textile Products, with annexes, effected by exchange of notes on 30 December 1977, as amended ("the Agreement"). I also refer to your letter of 24 July 1979 in which you request permission to exceed the consultation level for Category 636 for the 1979 agreement year. I wish to propose that the Agreement be further amended for the 1979 agreement year for Category 636 as follows:

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of India, this note and your note of confirmation on behalf of the Government of India shall constitute an agreement amending the Agreement.
