## ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

### Notification under Articles 7 and 8

### Agreement between Malaysia and Norway

The Textiles Surveillance Body has received from Malaysia a notification under Articles 7 and 8 of a new agreement concluded with Norway. This agreement covers the period 4 February 1978 to 31 December 1981.

This notification has been made in accordance with the request by the Textiles Committee that agreements concluded with non-participating countries in the Arrangement should be notified.

The TSB is circulating the notification to participating countries for their information.

For previous agreement, see COM.TEX/SB/200.

#### Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the negotiations held in Kuala Lumpur from 2 February to 4 February 1978 between a delegation from Norway and a delegation from Malaysia, and further to the Memorandum of Understanding on Trade in Textiles between Norway and Malaysia which was initialled on 4 February 1978.

I have the pleasure to confirm that the Government of Norway has accepted the terms for an agreement on this subject between the two Governments, which read as follows:

- 1. This agreement shall apply for the period 4 February 1978 to 31 December 1981.
- 2. This agreement shall apply to exports from Malaysia into Norway of textile products originating in Malaysia and listed in Annex I to this agreement.
- 3. Malaysia agrees to establish and maintain for each calendar year quantitative limits on its exports to Norway as set out in Annex II to this agreement.
- 4. Imports of textile products covered by this agreement which are not subject to quantitative limits shall be subject to a system of administrative control. These products will be subject to a dual system of export and import licensing.

When import licences of a product listed in Annex I, not subject to quota restraint, have been issued up to a level corresponding to 0.5 per cent for Group I and 1.5 per cent for Group II of the preceding year's total imports into Norway of that product, the Norwegian Government may request consultations in order to establish a quantitative limit for the product concerned.

Pending a mutually acceptable solution through these consultations the Norwegian Government may fix a quantitative limit at the volume reached by imports of the product in question in the twelve-month period preceding notification.

5. The Government of Malaysia will, for exports to Norway of products listed in Annex I, issue export licences and certificates of origin stating that these products are of Malaysian origin. A copy of such licence and certificate is attached to this agreement.

His Excellency, Datuk Hashim bin Sultan, Ambassador of Malaysia, Jakarta.

- 6. The Government of Norway will automatically issue import licences for the textile products listed in Annex I upon presentation of export licences as described in paragraph 5. For the textile products under quota restraint listed in Annex II such licences will only be issued automatically up to the agreed quota levels upon presentation of export licences as described in paragraph 5 provided that these licences are endorsed to the effect that the consignments concerned have been debited to the agreed limits.
- 7. Carry over and carry forward taken together shall not exceed 10 per cent, of which carry forward shall not represent more than 5 per cent.
- 8. The Government of Norway will inform the Government of Malaysia when imports into Norway of textile products that have been debited to the agreed limits are subsequently re-exported from Norway. The Government of Malaysia may then credit the quantities concerned to the appropriate limits.
- 9. The Government of Malaysia will provide the Government of Norway with quarterly statistics of the textile products listed in the Annex I licensed for export to Norway.
- 10. The Government of Norway will provide the Government of Malaysia with quarterly statistics of the import of the textile products listed in Annex I.
- 11. The Government of Malaysia shall endeavour to ensure that exports of textile products subject to quantitative limits are spaced out as evenly as possible over the year, due account being taken in particular of seasonal factors.
- 12. After the application of this Memorandum of Understanding for a period of two years, the quantitative limits may be revised by common accord in the light of the market situation in Norway.
- 13. The Annex to this Memorandum shall be considered an integral part of it.
- 14. The Government of Malaysia and the Government of Norway agree to consult together at the request of either party, on any matter arising from the implementation of this agreement.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of Malaysia I have the honour to suggest that the present note, together with Your Excellency's reply to that effect, should be regarded as constituting an Agreement between our two Governments in this matter.
