## Status of restrictions (Article 11:11 of the Multifibre Arrangement)

Mr. Chairman,

In accordance with your request and with the provisions of Article 11:11 of the Multifibre Arrangement, I have the honour to communicate the following:

Switzerland does not apply any quantitative restrictions within the meaning of Article 2, paragraphs 1 and 2 on imports of textile products and clothing from member countries of the Multifibre Arrangement. Automatic licences are nevertheless required for certain products, under the Federal Council Order of 8 December 1975, which we notified to you by letter of 8 January 1976 and which has not been emended since then.
