### ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

## Notification under Article 4:4

Amendment to the Agreement between the United States and Poland

The Textiles Surveillance Body has received a notification from the United States of two further amendments to its bilateral agreement with Poland, concluded under Article 4 of the Arrangement.<sup>1</sup>

# Note No. 3

The Embansy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Polish People's Republic and has the honor to refer to the agreement between the United States of America and the Polish People's Republic relating to trade in cotton, wool, and man-made fiber textiles, with annexes, effected by exchange of notes on January 6 and January 25, 1978, as amended ("The Agreement").

The Embassylproposes that the Agreement be amended to insert in Annex B-the following sub-limits of category 634 for the 1930 agreement gear:

Knit coats	3,500,000	Sye
Woven coats	1,500,000	SYE

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Polish People's Republic, this Note and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' Note of confirmation on behalf of the Government of the Polish People's Republic shall constitute an amendment to the Agreement.
