Reports on the Status of Restrictive Measures as requested by the TSB in accordance with Article 11

- 1. In preparation for the major review of the MFA to be conducted by the Textiles Committee in October 1980, and in fulfilling its obligations under Article 11 of the Arrangement, the TSB invited the Chairman to send a letter to participants in the Arrangement seeking information on restrictions maintained by them on textile products covered by the Arrangement.
- 2. At its meeting on 16-19 September 1980, the TSB completed its review of the replies to its request received by that date. The result of the TSB's consideration of these replies was included in the TSB's report to the Textiles Committee.
- 3. The replies received from participating courtries to the Chairman's letter are contained in the Addenda to this document.— Any replies subsequently received will be circulated in further Addenda.
