ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Article 4:4

Modification to the Bilateral Agreement between the EEC and India

The Textiles Surveillance Body has received from the Commission of the European Communities a notification concerning^{1/} a further modification to the bilateral agreement between the EEC and India.—

The TSB, pursuant to its procedures regarding bilateral agreements notified under Article 4^{2/}, has examined the relevant documentation and is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.




AGREED MINUTE

Delegations of the Republic of India and of the European Economic Community met on 28th January 1982 in Brussels in accordance with Arts 6 and 12 of the Agreement on trade in textiles products signed on 17 February 1981 between India and the Community.

As a result of these consultations, India agreed to limit its exports of products falling within Cat 17 to the Community's region of Ireland as follows :

1982 : 17,000 pieces.
