Notification under Article 7

Export Surveillance System Agreed Between Austria and Singapore

The Textiles Surveillance Body has received from Austria a notification of the establishment, pursuant to Article 7 of the MFA, of an export surveillance system for woven blouses exported from Singapore to Austria.

The TSB is transmitting this notification to participating countries for their information.

Dear Sir

I have the honour to refer to your letter dated 12 November 81 and to our discussion in Geneva on 21 November 81.

- I am pleased that Austria will not pursue its request for the conclusion of a restraint agreement in respect of exports of woven blouses of man-made fibres or of cotton from Singapore to Austria. In view of the circumstances surrounding the issue, Singapore is prepared to place exports of the aforementioned product under an export surveillance system. Under the system all exports of woven blouses of man-made fibres or of cotton from Singapore to Austria shall be accompanied by Certificates of Origin issued by the Certificate of Origin Office of the Controller of Imports and Exports Office, Singapore.
- 3 It is also agreed that there will be an exchange of monthly statistics on the trade in the aforementioned item between the two countries.
- The export surveillance system will come into effect on 1 January 1982. This arrangement shall not prejudice either of our Governments in future consultations.
- 5 Accept, Sir, the assurances of my highest consideration.
