## Modifications of Bilateral Agreement between the EEC and Korea

The Textiles Surveillance Body has received three notifications from the Commission of the European Communities relating to modifications of the bilateral agreement between the EEC and Korea, concerning new agreed limits on Category 13 for the Community, Category 74 for the United Kingdom and Ireland and Category 80 for the United Kingdom.

The TSB, pursuant to its procedure regarding bilateral agreements notified under Article 4, has examined the relevant documentation and is circulating the text of these notifications to participating countries for their information.

## AGREED MINUTE

Delegations of the Republic of Korea and of the European Economic Community met on 26 May 1982 in Brussels for consultations in accordance with Articles 6 and 13 of the EEC / Korea Agreement on trade in textile products signed on 12 September 1979.

1. As a result of these consultations, Korea agreed to limit its exports of briefs (category 13), women's suits and costumes (category 74) and babies' gamments (category 80) to the following levels:

• limitation agreed in December 1980.

Exceptionally, additional quantities have been agreed for United Kingdom and Denmark at the following respective levels: 300,000 pieces and 38,000 pieces, quantities to be shipped before 31 December 1982 (no carry-over).
