## ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

## <u>Reports on the Status of Restrictive Measures as</u> requested by the TSB in accordance with Article 11

1. In accordance with Article 11, paragraphs 11, 12 and 2 of the MFA, the Chairman of the TSB in July 1982 invited all participants to submit information on restrictions maintained by them on textile and clothing products covered by the Arrangement. Countries which had submitted reports at the time of the major review of the Arrangement in 1980 and the annual review in 1981 were asked to bring up to date the information supplied, taking account of new measures introduced, or any changes in such measures since the last report. Other participants were invited to submit full information on measures in force, by bringing up to date their original reports made under Article 2.

2. The replies received up to 29 November from participating countries to the Chairman's request are contained in Addenda to this document, as in the attached list. Any further replies will be circulated in subsequent addenda.

3. These replies are transmitted to participants for their information, in the context of the TSB's annual report to the Textiles Committee. The TSB has not yet reviewed these notifications, since notifications from a number of participants are still outstanding. It has been agreed to revert to the review of these notifications when a larger number of replies have been received. Participants are therefore urged to expedite their submissions.<sup>3</sup>
