ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Article 4:4

Amendment to the Bilateral Agreement between the United States and Romania

The Textiles Surveillance Body has received from the United States a notification of an amendment to their bilateral agreement with Romania, concluded under Article 4 of the MFA. In this amendment, the agreement period is changed to be from 1 April 1981 to 31 December 1984.

The TSB, pyrsuant to its procedures regarding bilateral agreements notified under Article 4°, has examined the relevant documentation and is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.

Dear Mr. Minister:

SPECIFIC LIMITS

I refer to the Agreement between the United States of America and the Socialist Republic of Romania relating to Trade in Wool and Man-Made Fiber Textiles and Textile Products, with Annexes, effected by exchange of notes September 3 and November 3, 1980, ("The Wool and Man-Made Fiber Agreement"), and to discussions held in Bucharest October 13-15, 1982, between representatives of our two Governments concerning exports of textile products from Romania to the United States. On behalf of my Government I would like to propose the following revisions under Article 18 of the Agreement:

Paragraph 1 shall be amended to read:

"The term of the Agreement shall be from April 1, 1981 through December 31, 1984. The first agreement period shall be from April 1, 1981 through March 31, 1982, the second agreement period shall be from April 1, 1982 through December 31, 1982, the third agreement period shall be from January 1, 1983 through December 31, 1983, and the fourth agreement period shall be from January 1, 1984 through December 31, 1984."

The United States Government will use all available flexibility to the 1982 level in order to minimize the amount of overshipments.

If this proposal is acceptable to your government, this letter and your letter of confirmation on behalf of your government shall constitute an amendment to the Agreement.
