## ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Reports on the Status of Restrictive Measures as requested by the TSB in accordance with Article 11

- 1. In accordance with Article 11, paragraphs 11, 12 and 2 of the MFA, the Chairman of the TSB in June 1983 invited all participants to submit information on restrictions maintained by them on textile and clothing products covered by the Arrangement, imported from all sources. Countries which had submitted reports in 1982 and contained in the series COM.TEX/SB/809 and Addenda were requested to update the information supplied in order to take account of new measures introduced, or any changes in such measures since the last report. Other participants were invited to submit full information, since their last report.
- 2. The replies received up to 2 November from participating countries to the Chairman's request for information are contained in Addenda to this document, as in the attached list. Any further replies will be circulated in subsequent addenda.
- 3. The TSB's annual report to the Textiles Committee will include summaries of information received from participating countries in 1982 and 1983.
